In biography, which is experienced as the living human temple, in which the 'l'-being of the individuality matures through love, the healing of personal suffering becomes the foundation for salutogenic fulfilment and social responsibility. Development happens through the individual search for ways in which to grow spiritual consciousness. Transformation happens through the individual deeds, which strives to create future destiny freedom.

Schooling Process Intervention Activity Service

A schooling in the development of the incarnating 'I' in the body, soul and spirit through transformational processes mediated by dynamic, creative, social-artistic instruments, as also through intervention, which existentially recognises and accompanies the healing power of the Higher Self in the biography, towards personal and vocational activity, wanting to serve contemporary society through self-fulfilment.

Admission

is based on vocational training, life experience and the requirement that one's own life has already been examined and documented according to the basic principles of biographical work, for example, under professional guidance, or through participation in seminars or courses, which encompass at least five hours intensive work with each seven year life phase. Whilst knowledge of Spiritual Science is not a prerequisite, an open mind is essential.

In addition, the applicant must be able to offer assurance that during the training they can acquire practical experience in a professional setting (project work).

Schedule

introduction: Michaelmas 2019; beginning: December 2019; completion: Summer 2022.

Duration

2 ½ years (27 months) with seven intensive weekend modules (Fri.15.00 - Sun.17.00 : 27 hrs), three extended weekday seminars (Wed.15.00 - So.17.00 : 51 hrs) and the certification module (Wed.15.00 - Sun.17.00 : 51 hrs), amounting to 393 training hours; with additionally c. 23 hours per month for study, presentations, project work as well as ongoing preparation and completion of I-documentation[©] for the certification, amounting to c. 1,000 training hours.

The total cost for ten weekend modules and three weekday seminars amount to € 4.800. to be settled by monthly payments of €200 within two years from beginning. Included are the costs of the venue, materials and provision of simple catering. Participants are responsible for arranging their own their accommodation. Additional expenses are incurred through participation in the certification module.

Certification

The certification follows after full attendance during the training and completion of the project work, by way of presenting complete I-documentation[©], including protocols of the training process, study, project work, practical experience, self-evaluation and formal evaluation. Participants must demonstrate convincingly that they actively acquired the nature and methods of work with biographical development during the training and can apply these independently.

Supervision

Additional guidance which cannot be provided within the framework of the training sessions, for example, with project work and preparation of I documentation[©], costs € 60 per hour.
